Jesus sending out his disciples (warriors)

*Go into all the world ... workplace, street, friends houses, family ... miraculous signs will accompany you who believe ... cast out demons speaking in tongues ... **They will be able to place their hands on the sick and they will be healed.***

Mark 16:15-18 NLT

This is our sending command from Jesus

I am willing ... be healed

² A man with leprosy came and knelt before him and said, “Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean.” ³ Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. “I am willing,” he said. “Be clean!” Immediately he was cured of his leprosy.

Mark 8:2,3 NIV

Let's look at the simple healing steps

Why did the leper go to Jesus?

- The man came to Jesus because he believed He had the power to heal.

“I am willing to be clean”

We know that God has the power but is he willing to heal us?

- The leper knew Jesus could meet every need.
- When we receive Jesus we receive everything!

“Jesus reached out and touched him”

What God does for us is a testimony to others.

- When God changes our lives, tell others.
- When God heals our life or someone else, tell others.
