



I. God has a Set Man

¹⁵ Moses said to the LORD, ¹⁶ "May the LORD, the God who gives breath to all living things, appoint someone over this community ¹⁷ to go out and come in before them, one who will lead them out and bring them in, so the LORD's people will not be like sheep without a shepherd." ¹⁸ So the LORD said to Moses, "Take Joshua son of Nun, a man in whom is the spirit of leadership, and lay your hand on him."

The Set Man

God sovereignly chooses His Man.

⁹ Now Joshua son of Nun was filled with the spirit of wisdom because Moses had laid his hands on him. So the Israelites listened to him and did what the LORD had commanded Moses.

The Set Man

God's plan has always been to choose a man.

- Set apart for a divine purpose
- Engineers circumstances to shape and fashion him
- God's likeness is formed
- The Holy Spirit brings forth his call and conviction

2. The Message

The integrity of his burden grows and expresses itself until a clear message is heard.

- The message is his passion, his lifestyle, his mindsets
- Sacrifices are motivated because of the burden of the message in his heart

The Message

The conviction and contents of his heart is fashioned.

⁷ "Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. ⁸ Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.

Lifestyle must correlate to the message you carry.

The Message

The message is a seed and must die first before it comes forth 30, 60, 100 fold.

¹⁵ Though he slay me, yet will I hope in him; I will surely defend my ways to his face.

3. The Ministry

The message matures in content and clarity.

A ministry is released.

- Others are drawn to the ministry that carries the message.
- The message is true and has a "magnetism" to draw people out into the open.

4. Masses

Multitudes are drawn to the Ministry.

- The message becomes the role model for others to pattern after.
 - It transforms lives, resources come to achieve it's destiny
 - The masses become an assembled army with corporate destiny.
 - The multitudes that are following reveal the magnitude of the impact the man, ministry and his message bring.

5. Momentum/Acceleration

Momentum grows and influences the hearts of men to accelerate.

- The dynamics of the spiritual momentum becomes unstoppable
- The synergy effect makes the message very appealing

Momentum

Momentum meets every obstacle head on.

Where is the message moving the people to.


