TRANSITION

- ◆ **Tran·si·tion (noun)**
- ◆ **Movement, passage, or change from one position, state, stage, subject, concept, etc, to another.**
- ◆ **The transition from adolescence to adulthood.**

Consider it all **joy**, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have *its* perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

James 1:2-4

The **JOY** of **TRIALS** in **TRANSITION**

So be truly glad! There is wonderful joy ahead, even though the going is rough for a while down here. These trials are only to test your faith, to see whether or not it is strong and pure. It is being tested as fire test gold and purifies it—and your faith is far more precious to God than mere gold; so if your faith remains strong after being tried in the test tube of fiery trials, it will bring **you** much praise and glory and honour on the day of His return.

1 Peter 1:6-7

KEY I: SUCCESS through the TRIALS in TRANSITION

David was seriously worried, for in their bitter grief for their children, his men began talking of killing him. But David took strength from the Lord.

1 Samuel 30:6

KEY 2: SUCCESS through the TRIALS in TRANSITION

David asked (inquired) the Lord, “Shall I chase them? Will I catch them?”

KEY 3: SUCCESS through the TRIALS in TRANSITION

Who may climb the mountain of the Lord and enter where He lives? Who may stand before the Lord?

Only those with **pure hands and hearts**, who do not practice dishonesty and lying.

They will receive God's own goodness as their blessing from Him, planted in their lives by God himself, their saviour.

These are the ones who are allowed to stand before the Lord and worship the God of Jacob.
